

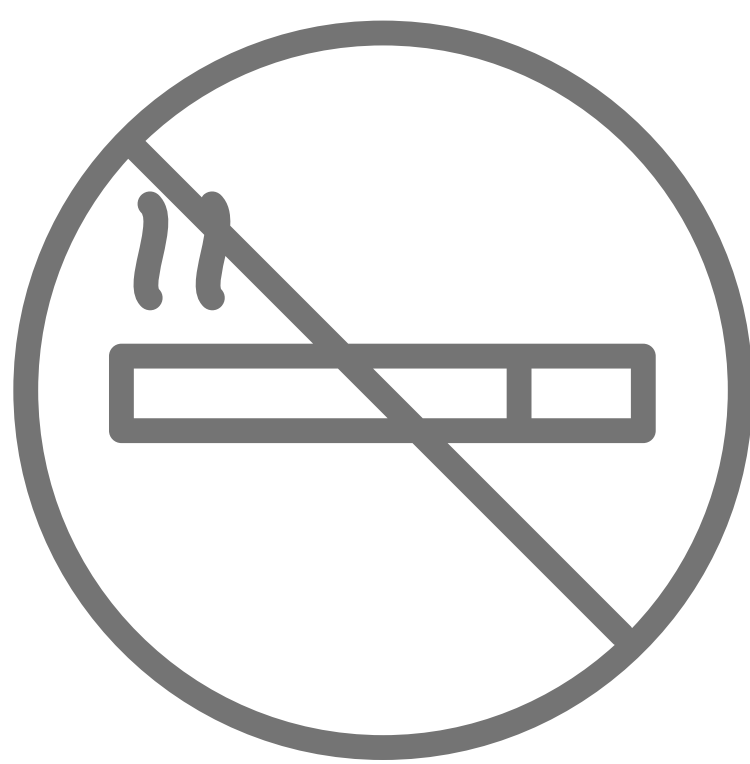

E-CIGARETTES

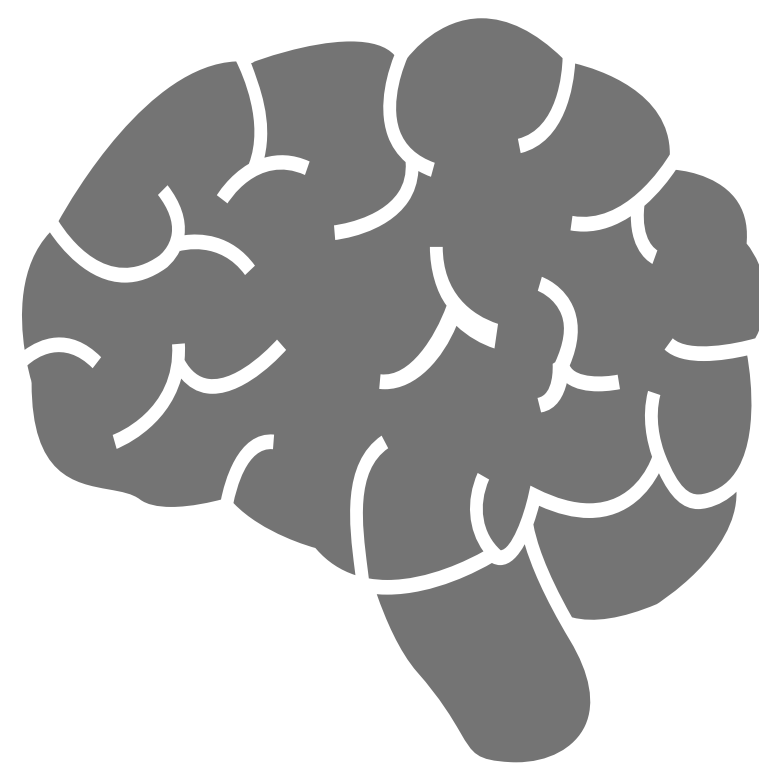
**E-cigarettes,

chemicals.**

This means
e-cigarettes are not
a healthier choice
for smokers and the
vapor produced is
not harmless water
vapor.

NC adolescents between 2011 and 2017.**
