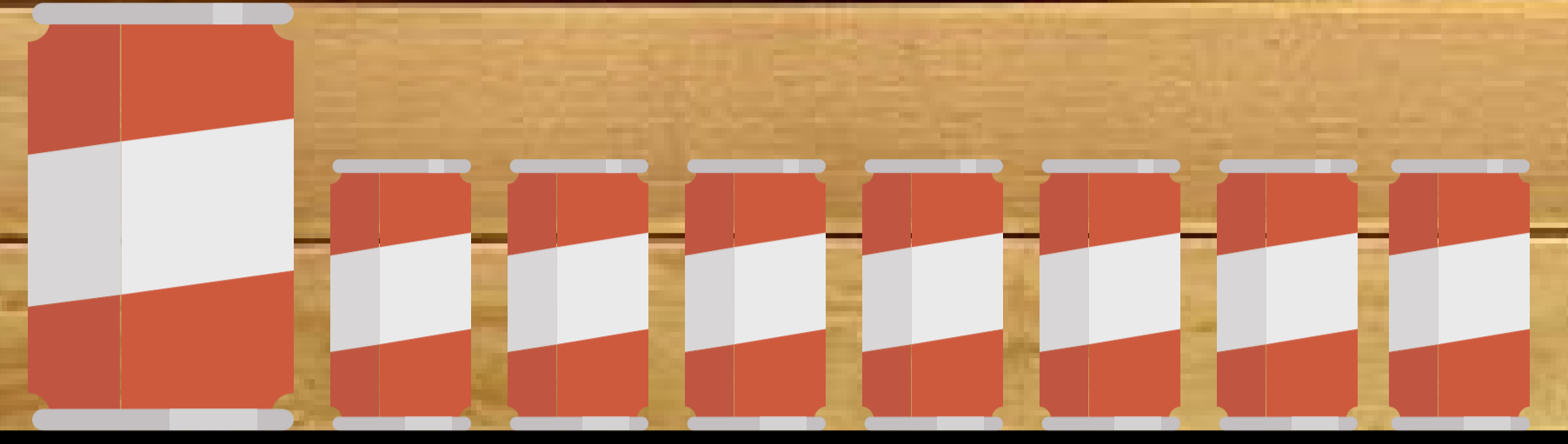


Food and Nutrition Services



1.3 million people in NC rely on SNAP

Helps 1 in 8 North Carolinians purchase the food they need to be healthy and productive



SNAP provides the average NC recipient household \$244 per month.

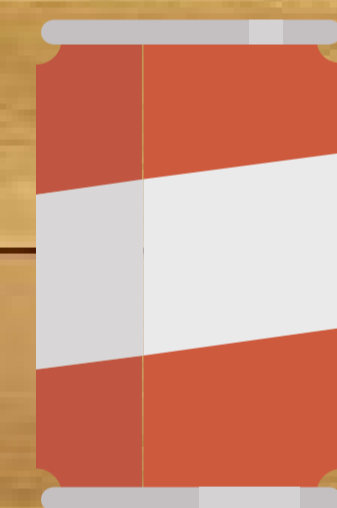
1/3 of SNAP households include elderly and disabled people



2/3 of SNAP households include children.



WIC serves more than 205,000 NC women, infants, and children.



Over \$90 million in food

More than **2 million** North Carolinians are food insecure, and federal food and nutrition services, including the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) and the Women, Infant, and Children Program (WIC), are critical resources that lift people out of poverty and reduce food insecurity.

It is critical that North Carolina increases access to these vital services, streamlines services, and increases purchasing power of participants.
